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School and Community

Putnam City School District serves the educational needs of ~19,213 students in northwest Oklahoma City, consisting of 42 square miles and including three high schools, five middle schools, and eighteen elementary schools utilizing a K-5, 6-8, 9-12 grade-level configuration. It is accredited by North Central Association, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma Secondary Schools Association.

Putnam City North employs two 18-week semesters with a 7 class per day, 50 minute per class schedule. PCN partners with Oklahoma State University-Oklahoma City to offer concurrent opportunities both on and off campus for our juniors and seniors. Francis Tuttle Technology Center offers 20 different career technology programs to our students for free at their campus, including the competitive, college preparatory BioScience and Medicine, Computer Science, and Pre-Engineering Academies.

Graduation Requirements

College Prep Curriculum

25 credits English (4), Mathematics (3), Science – Biology, Chemistry, Physics (3), Social Studies (3), Physical Education (½), The Arts (1), World Language (2 credits of same language) **OR** college-approved Computer Technology (2 credits), Financial Literature (1/2) **and** 1 additional core, world language, or computer course

Minimum Curriculum:

25 credits English (4), Mathematics (3), Science (3), Social Studies (3), Physical Education (½), the Arts (1), Computer Technology (1) **OR** World Language (1)

Valedictorian:To be Valedictorian, the student must be ranked in the top 1 percent of the class.



GPA and Class Rank

Unweighted GPA is based on a 4.0 scale. Weighted GPA is based on a 4.5 scale for Honors, AP or concurrent classes, and a 5.0 scale for AP classes with a passing score on the AP exam. Class rank is based on weighted GPA

Learning Plans and Special Programs

Putnam City North offers multiple learning plans, including special education and gifted programs. Students utilizing IEPs have a special education advisor who helps meet their needs and plan their schedule. Gifted students are advised by Mrs. McGrath-Malahy, the College Advisor. Academic counselors aid all students in academic advisement and tracking credits toward graduation and comfort students in need, and help families find resources.

PCN has a College and Career Office available to every student and offers special leadership and academic programs, including Link Crew (a mentoring program); National Honor Society; and an award winning, nationally recognized student council (SUN-Students United at North).

Covid-19 Update for Putnam City Schools

As with so many districts across the country, Putnam City Schools and students have been profoundly affected by Covid-19.

Notable Issues:

- Our students have been fully virtual since mid-March of 2020.
- The state of Oklahoma normally provides a free Junior ACT test. This test was cancelled, and on Sept 17th of 2020 the state informed Oklahoma schools they would not be issuing a makeup exam. Many of our students and families have been unable to take a college placement exam and were awaiting a make-up opportunity.
- Sports and extracurricular activities, including leadership and service opportunities, were cancelled for the Spring of 2020 and are currently only available on a limited basis.
